The following are the observations from the Academic and Administrative Audit based on the reports submitted by The Standard Fireworks Rajaratnam College for Women, Sivakasi for the academic year 2019-20.

Appreciations:

- The College has been selected as a mentor institution under UGC PARAMARSH Scheme and UGC has sanctioned Rs.30 lakhs for this scheme.
- 2. It is noteworthy that the institution had received grant from DST-FIST.
- It is highly appreciable that IQAC developed an OBE model following the parameters suggested by UGC and implemented the Outcome Based Education in the year 2019-20
- Workshops were organized in groups for staff members and external examiners and exposed various parameters of SFRC- OBE.
- A good number of SFRCians were qualified NET/SET and completed online NPTEL courses.
- The attainment of students are monitored by the Academic Attainment Committee and submitted to the IQAC.



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- Videos and e-contents developed by the staff are uploaded in the YouTube Channel SFRC CONNECT.
- Staff members were attending and presenting research papers regularly including International seminars organized outside India.
- 9. A good number of Research articles and Books were published by the faculty.
- 10. The initiative of Young Women Entrepreneur Development Cell (YWED) and 6 Start Ups by the Standardpreneur cell are unique to the institution and it deserves appreciation for its all possible steps taken to improve entrepreneurial development.
- 11. Faculty members and students brought many laurels to the institution for their services and achievements.
- Receiving 3 patents by the staff from an institution from a rural backdrop is a great achievement.
- 13. The establishment of Audio Visual Centre, Green Matte Studio and Lecture Capturing System adds to the ICT enabled teaching and learning process
- 14. The efforts of the management to constantly improve the infrastructure to meet its growing needs are noteworthy.
- 15. A linkage with the Institute of Language Management, Bangalore to instill selfconfidence in the students to communicate effectively is appreciable.
- Expressive Articulation Sessions conducted twice in a month to improve the oratory and other individual skills among students deserves appreciation.
- Budget proposal and allotment of funds on various heads were properly done for the financial year 2019-20.
- 18. Certificate of Appreciation was bestowed on the college for creating the ecoconscious awareness under "One Student One Tree" initiative by the AICTE (All India Council for Technical Education), New Delhi.
- The Certificate of World Record by the Noble World Records for the World's Largest Human Tree Formation consisting of 966 participants is laudable.
- The contribution of students and staff in extension and outreach activities is appreciable.

Suggestions:

- The format followed in presenting the feedback from students, staff and research scholars in the Dean's meeting which is placed in the Governing Body is not proper. Feedback discussed in the IQAC obtained in a five point scale and analysed with the graphs with the Action Taken Report shall be placed in the Governing Body.
- More number of placements may be arranged for students. Graduate Outcome shall be projected.
- Students' strength in some SF courses are seen with lot of fluctuations over the years. Steps may be taken to maintain the maximum allotted strength.



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- Steps have to be taken to increase the number of Ph.d Scholars.
- 5. Number of Research Guides shall be increased.
- All PG departments shall be promoted as Research Departments.
- Faculty shall be encouraged to publish the articles in Scopus and UGC care listed journals only.
- 8. Proper guidance shall be given to faculty to get more funded research projects
- To facilitate inter-disciplinary and collaborative Researches, a suitable environment may be created.
