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12.01.03 Dr.D.Sasireka, The Chairman gave an introductory note in which she presented the following:

On the occasion of the Golden Jubilee Celebrations, the college takes pride in being granted extension of the status of College with Potential for Excellence for the years 2017 to 2022.

The curricular body of the institution consists of 73 courses, out of which many a course has been hybridized to suit the needs of industry. Revision and review of syllabi have been carefully done to meet the academic as well as the employability needs. An innovative Young Women Entrepreneurship Development Centre has been inaugurated to co-ordinate entrepreneurship development activities held at various levels in the college.

With the meticulous support of the Management Committee members, several infrastructural additions have been actualized. The new Indoor Sports Training Facility has been upgraded to a fully air-conditioned stadium. Additional floors have been constructed in PG hostel and library. Extension of gymnasium has also been effected.

The research-supportive campus has a total of 55 faculty members holding doctoral degrees; major and minor research projects are also regularly carried out by our staff members. A few faculty members have also undertaken foreign visits to attend international conferences and seminars as part of their academic enrichment. In addition, our faculty members willingly take part in the Refresher courses conducted in other states. This results in a vibrant sharing of know-how with teachers at a national level, and the knowledge, in turn, trickles down to our students strikingly.

The industrious faculty practices updating of knowledge and practice in their respective fields as regularity. Therefore, as many as 15 teachers have cleared SET exam in the past academic year and two scholars have cleared NET in Tamil.
