

- ☆ The tutors are asked to discuss the students' performance in the Term Test I & II and to advise the slow learners to perform well in the III Term Test to get pass marks in the internal.
- Course teachers are asked to give small slip test / definitions / small questions during the class hours to enhance the performance of the students.
- ☆ There will be no retest for the students at any cost.
- Students are asked to submit their records/assignments in time before the commencement of III Term Test and are asked to complete their practical works for internal assessment.
- Students' attendance should be insisted. If a student discontinues her studies during the semester, she would be able to continue her studies only in the next academic year.
- Students should be made aware End Semester Examination aggregate marks UG-40 marks, PG/ M.Phil - 50 marks.
- ☆ Students must be asked to get their mark statements for all the certificate programmes conducted during April 2019 from COE Office without fail.
- Students have to check initial, spelling and make note of their register numbers in the nominal roll and hall tickets and to ensure their correctness.
- ☆ Ask the students to refer the notice board for the practical examination schedule.
- ☆ Students should bring their Hall-ticket and ID card to the End Semester Examination (Theory & Practical). Students who have forgotten to bring ID should pay ₹ 30/- and ₹ 100/- for hall-ticket as penalty and enter their names, major, subject code of the paper of that day in the register kept in the COE Office before entering the Examination hall to get the duplicate Hall Ticket.
- ☆ Students are instructed to put the subdivisions a/b along with question number in the answer script.
- ☆ As per the UGC guidelines, if there is a charge of malpractice on a student, she should be sent out of the examination hall and given chance during next semester only. The courses, she has already appeared during that semester will not be valued.
- ☆ As per the UGC norms if any student discontinues her study or does not clear the arrears a grace period of 2 years only will be given for both UG and PG students to complete their course.
- ☆ Students are strictly instructed to listen to the announcements made regarding placement, and scholarship.
- The tutors are asked to record the activities of the students regularly to update the profile of their wards.
- Tutors are asked to instruct the students about outcome based education including the Co's and K's with anyone of the Model question paper.

- The tutors are asked to check their wards attendance in COP programmes / Extra Credit Course/ Certificate Course offered in the college and also in Remedial Coaching classes.
- ☆ Students should be made aware of the minimum required pass marks in the Internal. UG - 14/25; PG & M.Phil - 16/25. There will be no retest for the students at any cost.
- Final year students those who are interested can enroll their names for Certificate Programme on Basic accounting and accounting practices for employment opportunities in the Commerce Department (R).
